Place a Hold allows you to reserve materials from any library in the county for pick-up at your closest library. A library card is required.

FREE premium databases, trade journals and newspapers. All you need is a FREE library card to access from home or office @ hcplc.org.

Lexis-Nexis Congressional & State Capital -
