 And I can hold them just so.

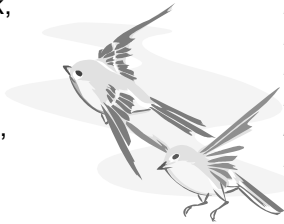
Hold up baby's hands.
